- The host country: 6 male and 6 female competitors for each age group and category.
- Extra quota: All reigning World and Continental Champions for Adults and Youth, who fulfil the geographical requirement and the age requirements in accordance with Article 9.2.1, shall have the status of extra-quota competitors for the discipline in which they are Champions.

- Boy : Junior (Age 18-19), Youth A (Age 16-17), Youth B (Age 14-15)
- Girl : Junior (Age 18-19), Youth A (Age 16-17), Youth B (Age 14-15)
